Chairman Bell called the meeting to order. Vice Chairman Bolding made a motion to approve the minutes of the October 11th meeting, seconded by Mr. Mullican, approved 5-0.

With no citizen, staff, or board comments, the board welcomed 7-Eleven, Inc. represented by Danielle Elks as local counsel. Ms. Elks explained that they were not planning on doing any changes immediately and that 7-Eleven was purchasing all Sonoco properties, forty locations in Middle Tennessee. The closing has been postponed several times and yesterday's update was probably as late as mid-December. Mr. Bolding made a motion that a permit be issued, contingent upon the transfer of the property. If it is not transferred before the February board meeting 7-Eleven Inc. is required to appear before the board. Seconded by Mr. Mayes the board voted 5-0. Further discussion regarding their purchases revealed that they do intend to change the property names to 7-Eleven in the future and that they may make structural changes at that time.

Mr. Bolding made a motion to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 9.06.
