MINUTES OF MEETING

Chairman Bell called the meeting to order. Mr. Henry Bolding made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 14th meeting, seconded by Mr. Carl Sloan, approved 5-0.

There were no citizen or staff comments. Chairman Bell asked the representative of Silverado Sports Bar and Grill to come before the board. Mr. Joseph Patton represented Silverado's in the matter of having an outdoor event with no special event permit. Chairman Bell explained that Silverado's has always gotten a special event permit for their bike night events and he explained no one has gotten a permit this year. Mr. Patton explained they were trying to have bike nights different this year and not serve alcohol in the parking lot, they were supposed to drink inside and not in the parking lot. The caution tape was there to protect the motorcycles from the cars. City Manager Tim Ellis informed Mr. Patton that they were drinking beer in the parking lot that night. Mr. Ellis asked if they didn't have two places set up to sell alcohol outside. Mr. Ellis provided the Board and Mr. Patton with a photograph he had taken on May 9th during the event that shows two stands selling beer set up in their patio space, as well as patrons walking in the parking lot consuming alcohol. Mr. Patton stated he couldn't see that people were consuming alcohol based on the photograph and a few examples were pointed out to him. He said he believed what the board was telling him but that wasn't their intent. Their intent was for them to stay on the patio and not be in the parking lot. He also said that people just don't care anymore and he can't keep them from slipping it in their bags and taking alcohol into the parking lot anyway. Mr. Patton explained since they had no intention of them being in the parking lot they didn't get the permit.

Chairman Bell asked Mr. Patton how we were going to resolve this issue and Mr. Patton stated they would do whatever the Board wanted them to do. Chairman Bell explained if they were going to have drinking in the parking lot that he was going to need to get a permit. Chairman Bell asked the Board if they had any comments. With no Board comments Chairman Bell asked Chief Goodwin if he had any. Chief Goodwin explained that we've always given the permit in the past, and that there's never been a problem in the past with bike night. As Mr. Patton explained earlier he can't keep people from taking the alcohol in the parking lot and Chief agreed if you can't keep people from violating the law you might as well get the permit and be legal.

The Board took a short recess for Silverado's to figure up how many days they needed for a permit so they could go ahead and apply while they were at the meeting. Mr. Patton decided on 15 weeks total for bike nights. Tim made sure that Mr. Patton was aware with this special event permit that no children would be allowed inside the fenced in area where alcohol was being served. The total for the special event permit was \$1,000 including each event and the application fee. Mr. Ellis, Mr. Bell and Mr. Patton all agreed that this was a misunderstanding as Mr. Patton was unaware that the patrons had the alcohol in the parking lot. Mr. Jerry Mayes made a motion to allow the special event permit for the next 15 weeks under the understanding that this not be considered a violation against them and we move forward from here. Seconded by Mr. Carl Sloan, the board voted 5-0

Tim thanked the board in their grace for how they handled this situation. Mr. Bolding made a motion to adjourn. Seconded by Mr. Sloan the board voted 5-0. Meeting adjourned at 9:24.
